

Cut Flower Basics



ROSES

Last 5 - 7 days

To Keep Them Fresh:

Feed and change water
ever other day

Cut an inch off stems
each time you change water

Avoid direct sunlight

Red roses symbolize passionate,
romantic love





CARNATIONS

Last 7 – 14 days
To Keep Them Fresh:

Feed and change water
every 2 – 3 days

Avoid heat vents and
direct sunlight

Don't place near fruits that
release ethylene gas

Carnations symbolize devotion
and love





Hydrangeas

Last 7 – 14 days

To Keep Them Fresh:

Feed and change water
every other day

Use cool water

Mist petals daily

Avoid heat vents and
direct sunlight

Submerge for 5 – 10 minutes
if wilted

STOCKS

Last 7 - 14 days

To Keep Them Fresh:

Feed and change water
every 2 - 3 days

Avoid heat vents and
direct sunlight

Needs good air circulation
to prevent mildew

Last 7 - 14 days

Feed and change water
every day
Use cool water
Avoid heat vents and
direct sunlight

Last 5 – 7 days
To Keep Them Fresh:
Feed and change water
every day
Use cool water
Avoid drafts and
direct sunlight

ALSTROEMERIA

Last 10 – 14 days

To Keep Them Fresh:

Feed and change water

every day

Use cool water

Place in indirect light

Keep away from fresh fruits

and vegetables

FREESIAS

Last 14 – 21 days

To Keep Them Fresh:
Feed and change water
every day

Use cool water

Avoid drafts and
direct sunlight

Remove spent flowers
